The Corporate Confession of Sin

Elder:: Blessed Jesus, you offered us all your blessings when you announced...“Blessed are the poor in spirit” —

People: but we have been rich in pride.

Elder:: “Blessed are those who mourn” —

People: but we have not known much sorrow for our sin.

Elder:: “Blessed are the meek” —

People: but we are a stiff-necked people.

Elder: “Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness”

People: but we are filled to the full with other things.

Elder: “Blessed are the merciful” —

People: but we are harsh and impatient.

Elder: “Blessed are the pure in heart” —

People: but we have impure hearts.

Elder: “Blessed are the peacemakers” —

People: but we have not sought reconciliation.

Elder: “Blessed are those who are persecuted because of righteousness” —

People: but our lives do not challenge the world.

Elder: “Blessed are you when people insult you, persecute you and falsely say all kinds of evil against you because of me” —

People: but we have hardly made it known that we are yours.

Elder: Your Law is holy and your blessings are perfect, but they are both too great for us. You alone are blessed.

All: We confess to you: Lord, though you should guide us, we

inform ourselves; though you should rule us, we control

ourselves; though you should fulfill us, we console ourselves.

We plead with you to forgive our sins and give us the blessing of

your righteousness. Our King and Father, your Son died and

was raised up in power. Now enable us to die to our sin in

repentance so we may rise to new life in Him for the sake of

your Son, who loves us and gave himself for us. Amen.

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has

The Confession of Faith – Heidelberg Catechism #31-32

Q31. Why is he called "Christ", that is anointed?

Answer: Because he is ordained of God the Father, and anointed with the Holy Ghost, to be our chief Prophet and Teacher, who has fully revealed to us the secret counsel and will of God concerning our redemption; and to be our only High Priest, who by the one sacrifice of his body, has redeemed us, and makes continual intercession with the Father for us; and also to be our eternal King, who governs us by his word and Spirit, and who defends and preserves us in that salvation, he has purchased for us.

Q32. But why art thou called a Christian?

Answer: *Because I am a member of Christ by faith, and thus am partaker of his anointing; that so I may confess his name, and present myself a living sacrifice of thankfulness to him: and also that with a free and good conscience I may fight against sin and Satan in this life and afterwards I reign with him eternally, over all creatures.*
